SUBJECT: Designation of Authority—Office of the Chief Technology Officer

By virtue of the authority vested in me as City Administrator by section 422(7) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 790; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(7)), and Mayor's Order 2015-036, dated January 9, 2015, and by all other applicable laws, regulations, Mayor's Orders, and other grants of authority, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. During a period of absence of the Chief Technology Officer of the Office of the Chief Technology Officer ("OCTO"), Stephen Miller, Deputy Chief Technology Officer of OCTO, shall have the authority to:
 - a. Approve and execute contracts, memorandums of understanding, and other agreements of OCTO; and
 - b. Approve the obligation and expenditure of funds from the budget of OCTO.
2. Notwithstanding the designation of authority set forth in paragraph 1 of this Order, the Chief Technology Officer of OCTO retains concurrent authority over all matters described in paragraph 1 of this Order.
3. This Order supersedes City Administrator's Order 2023-8, dated December 21, 2023, and all other prior City Administrator's Orders to the extent of any inconsistency.
4. This Order shall be effective immediately and shall expire at 11:59 p.m. on February 7, 2024.
