
CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S ORDER

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority to the Director of the Department of Human Resources—
Personnel Actions Related to the DC Contact Trace Force

By virtue of the authority vested in me as City Administrator by section 422(7) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 790; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(7)), and Mayor's Order 2015-036, issued January 9, 2015, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Director of the Department of Human Resources ("DCHR Director") is delegated the authority set forth in section 5(b)(16) of the District of Columbia Public Emergency Act of 1980, effective March 5, 1981 (D.C. Law 3-149; D.C. Official Code § 7-2304(b)(16)), as added by section 507(a)(4) of the Coronavirus Support Emergency Amendment Act of 2020, effective May 27, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-326; — DCR —), section 507(a)(4) of the Coronavirus Support Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2020, effective June 9, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-328; — DCR —), and any substantially similar subsequent emergency, temporary, or permanent legislation, for the purposes of establishing, staffing, and implementing the DC Contact Trace Force.
2. The DCHR Director is delegated the authority provided by section 422(2), (3), and (4) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 790; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(7)), and the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Official Code § 1-601.01 *et seq.*) ("CMPA") to take any action authorized to be taken by a personnel authority under the CMPA, with respect to any employee who serves in a full-time or part-time capacity on the DC Contract Trace Force, regardless of whether the DCHR Director would otherwise serve as the personnel authority for the employee.
3. This Order shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* to May 27, 2020.
