SUBJECT:

Delegation of Authority to the Chief of Police—Extension of Certain Licenses to

Carry a Concealed Pistol

By virtue of the authority vested in me as City Administrator by section 422(7) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 790; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(7)), and Mayor's Order 2015-036, issued January 9, 2015, and pursuant to section 312 of the Coronavirus Support Temporary Amendment Act of 2021, effective June 24, 2021 (D.C. Law 24-9; 68 DCR 4824), as amended by section 3(p) of the Public Emergency Extension and Eviction and Utility Moratorium Phasing Emergency Amendment Act of 2021, effective July 24, 2021 (D.C. Act 24-125; 68 DCR 7342), any subsequent, substantively similar provision in emergency or temporary legislation, Mayor's Order 2020-079, dated July 22, 2020, and Mayor's Order 2021-096, dated July 24, 2021, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

- 1. The Chief of Police of the Metropolitan Police Department is delegated the authority, during the period from the effective date of this Order until November 5, 2021, to prospectively or retroactively extend the validity of a license to carry a concealed pistol that expired or would otherwise expire, pursuant to section 903 of the Firearms Control Regulations Act of 1975, effective June 16, 2015 (D.C. Law 20-279; D.C. Official Code § 7-2509.03); provided, that the validity of such a license shall not be extended to a date that is later than November 5, 2021.
- 2. This Order shall become effective immediately.
