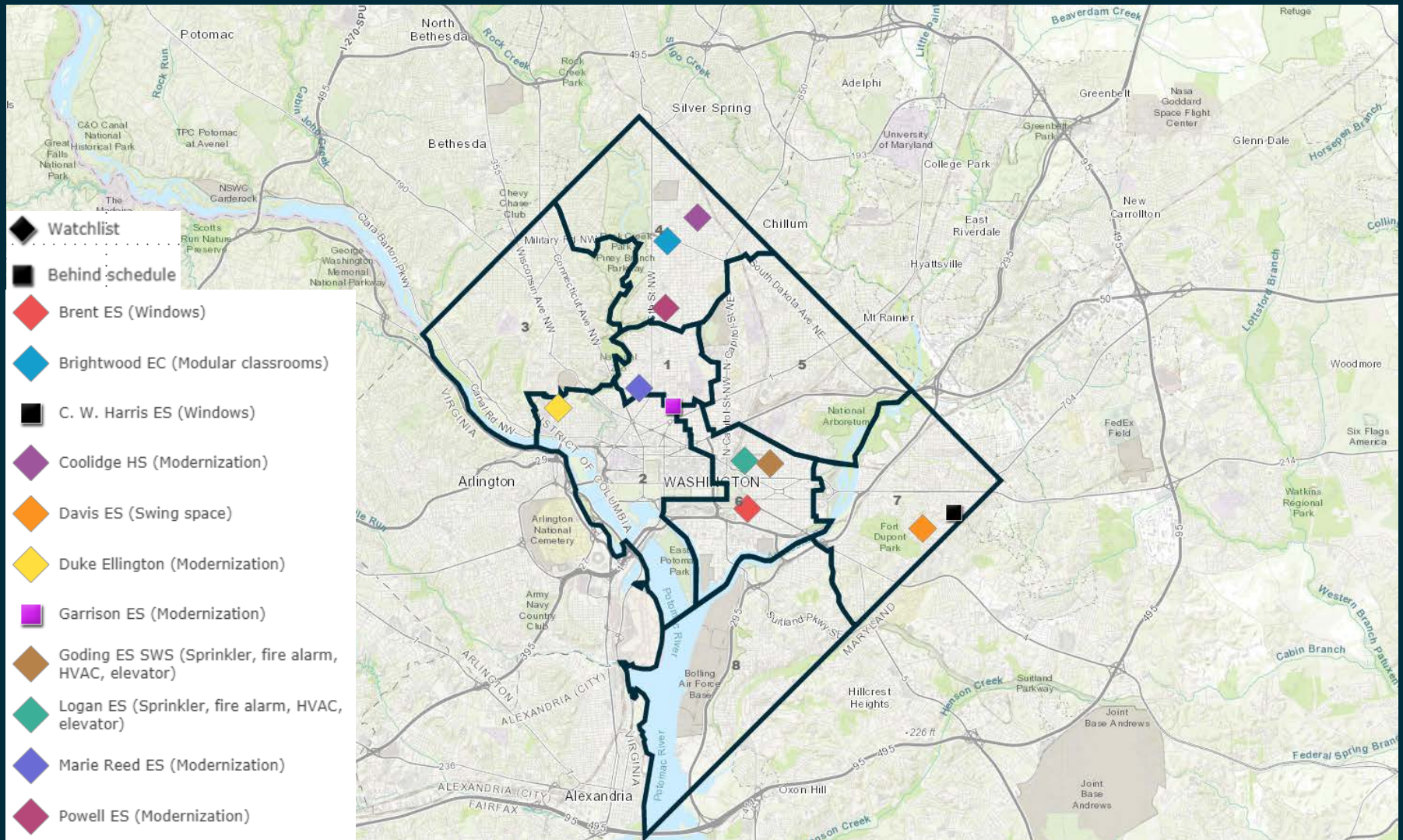

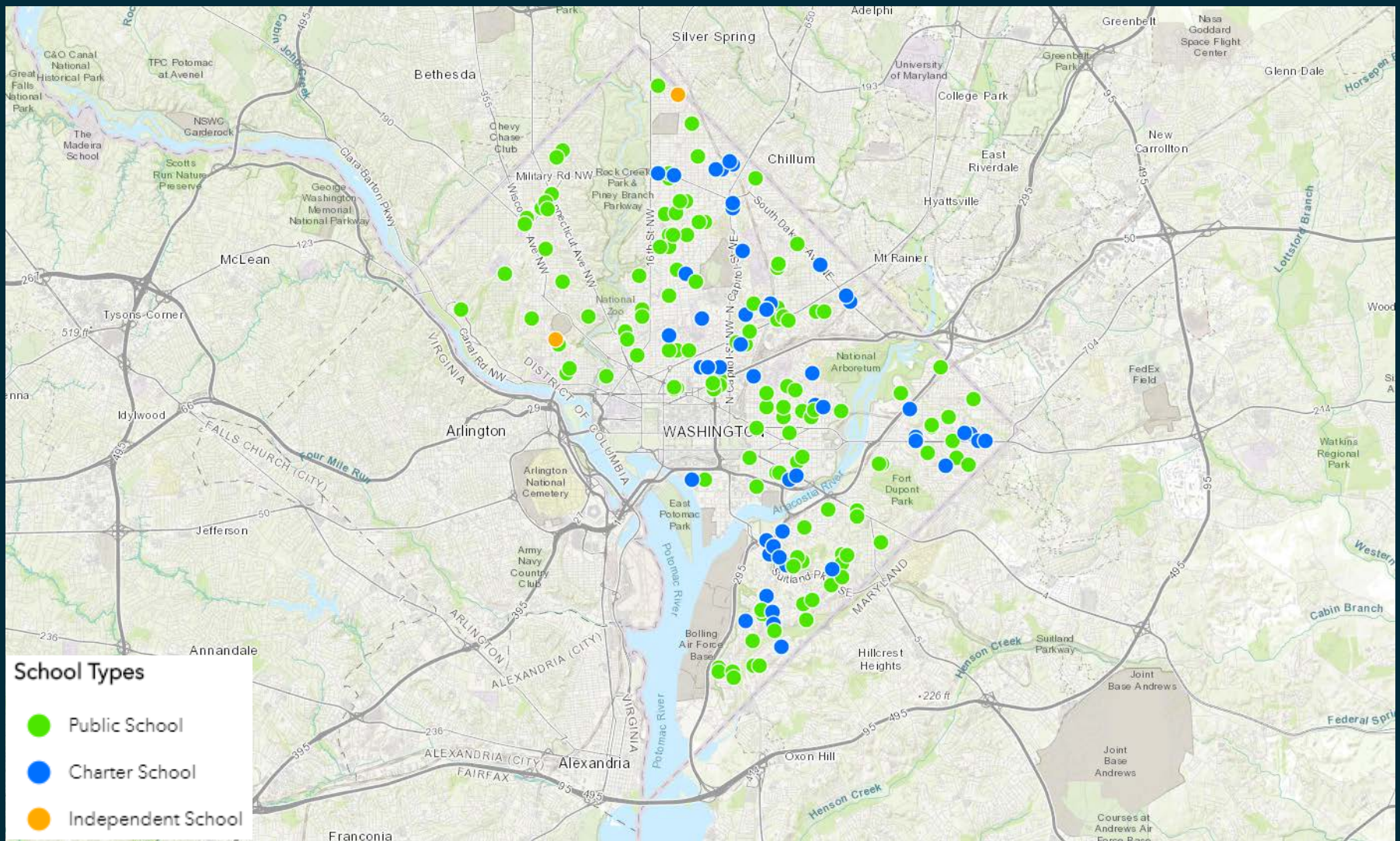

DDOT School Crossing Guard Deployment

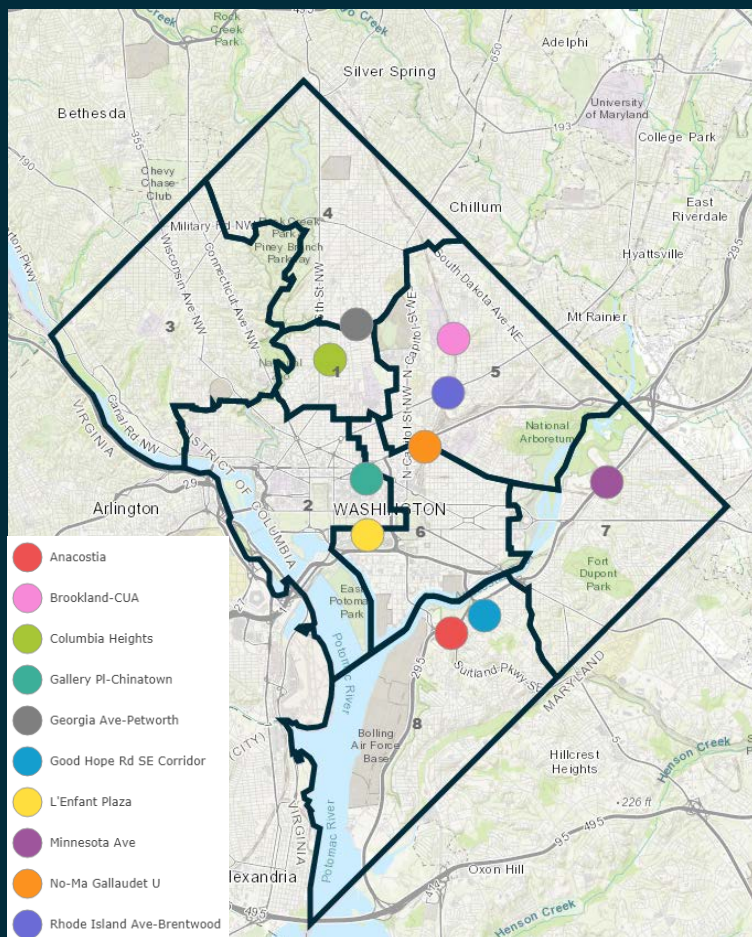

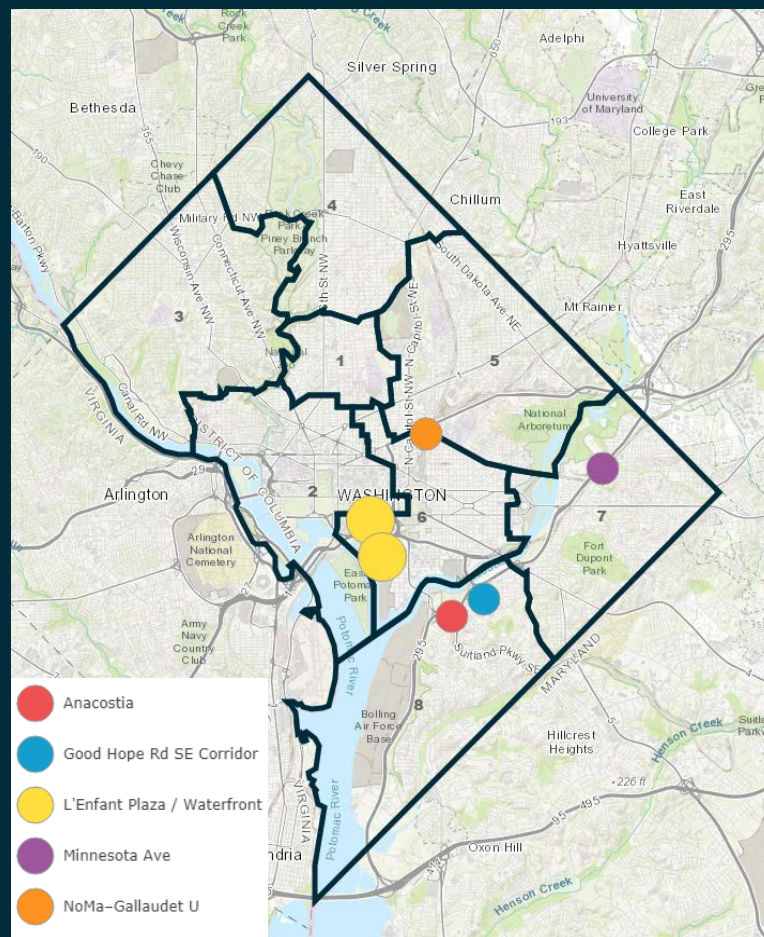

Kids Ride Free

Update

- **Fare leniency**

- Since 7/20 STAT: DDOT and DME have engaged w/WMATA
- Next step: CA to engage w/WMATA GM
 - Ask: Leniency from station managers during the weeks of August 21st and August 28th to ensure students with malfunctioning DC One Cards can still ride

- **Enrollment**

- Over 18,000 DC One Cards have been preloaded, 96% of active cards

- **Fair Share Expansion**

- WMATA has not shared Fair Share stops w/the District
- DME and DDOT have requested additional information about the stations that will be impacted. WMATA has agreed to release the locations of the expansion with adequate notice to allow for targeted outreach to LEAs in the impacted areas

Communication / Outreach Plan*

- DME is working with DDOT, as well as DCPS and PCSB, to reinforce WMATA's message that students will need to tap a valid DC One Card for bus and rail
- DME and DDOT are working with WMATA to complete outreach at high-traffic metro stations and at events for school leaders

School Health Services

- Staff currently on board can provide coverage to 87% of schools w/an approved health suite
- Staffing agencies, float pools, and managers will be used to cover vacancies and absences

- Rollout of revised Administration of Medication training set for September

Water Filtration in DCPS Schools

Testing Update / Schedule

- **Cost:** \$365,000
- **Timeline:** 3 months; Oct. 16th – Dec. 11th
- **Strategy:**
 - 9-16 schools tested per week
 - Elementary schools prioritized, with most year-round ES tested in 1st week
 - Schools with multiple sink tagouts in SY16-17 prioritized
 - High schools w/daycare facilities prioritized
- **Next Steps:**
 - Result are received within 5 business days of testing
 - Results will be posted on DGS website (linked to both DCPS and DPR sites)

Communication Plan

- DME, DCPS, and DGS coordinating on communication plan to engage stakeholders (students, parents, school staff)
- Plan to be finalized the week of August 7th
- Outreach to begin no later than August 31st

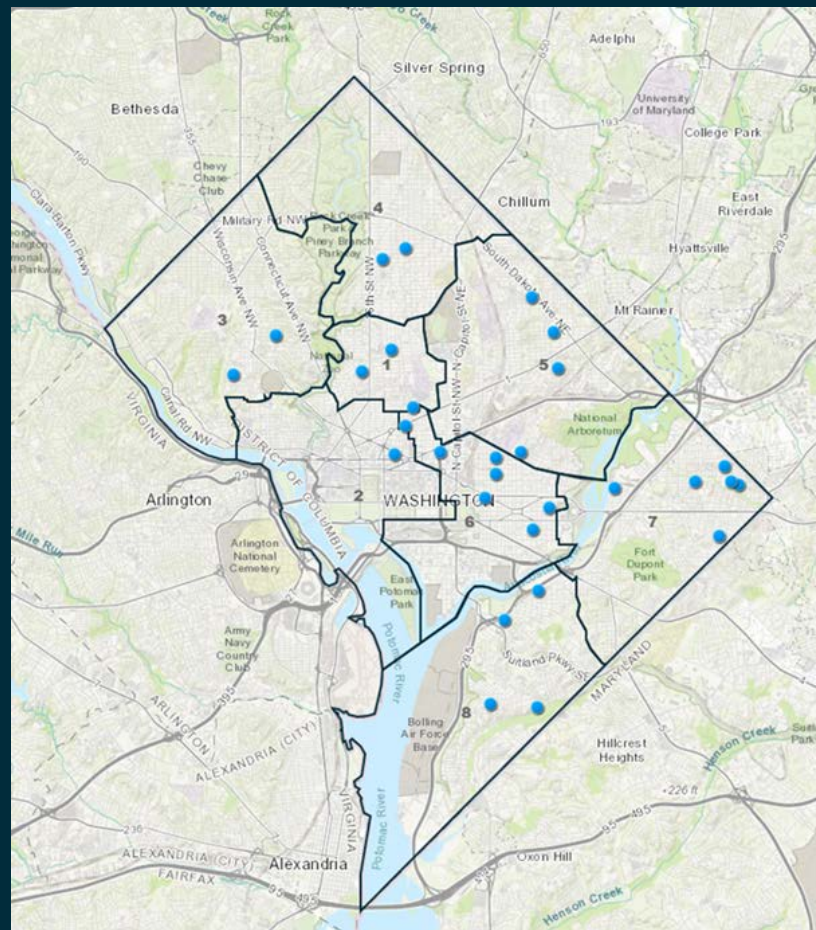
Water Filtration: Update on Tagouts

Tagouts:

- 103 device tagouts; 29 schools

Update:

- All of the new faucets have been received
- 50% have been installed to date; 100% by August 10
- Test results will be received the week of August 14
- If results are below actionable level, faucets will be turned back on accordingly

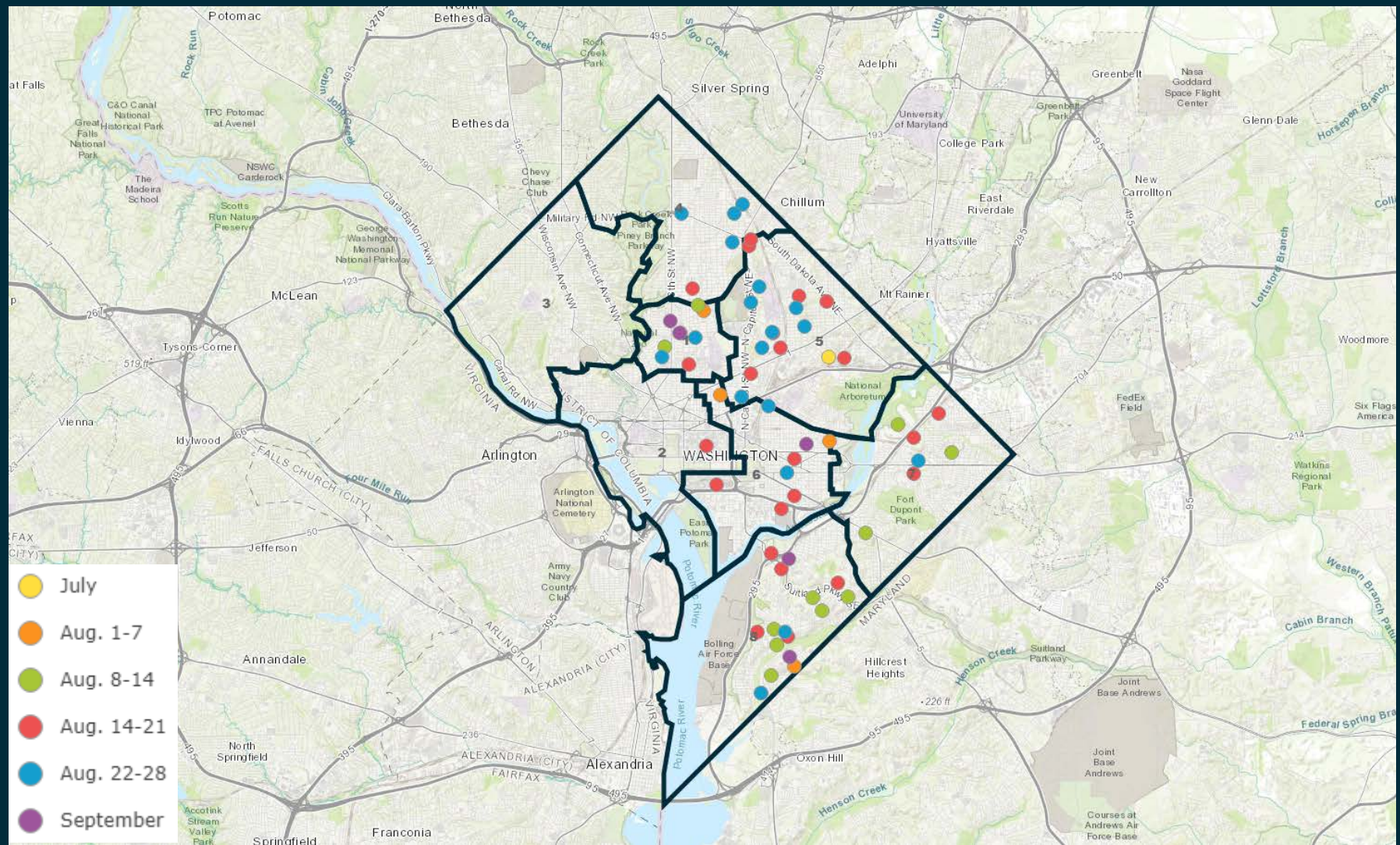

STUDENT CHECKLIST

2 WEEKS BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS

- ☒ Make sure you are enrolled in a DC public or public charter school.
- ☒ Find your DC One Card or contact your school if you do not have one.
- ☒ Confirm your pass is loaded by checking your card status at dconecard.dc.gov or calling 202-673-1740.
- ☒ If your pass is NOT loaded, follow the pass loading instructions before school starts.

Private school students are still required to see their ID administrator and then register at dconecard.dc.gov to participate in the Kids Ride Free on Bus program. Private school students are not eligible for the free Metrorail benefit but can purchase the \$30 monthly pass.

IF YOUR PASS IS NOT LOADED, FOLLOW THESE STEPS

OPTION 1 Load at Metrorail Station

Best option!

1. Take your DC One Card to a Metrorail station and tap it at a fare vending machine. If you see a negative balance, add money to bring it up to \$0.



Negative balances block the pass from working.



2. On the **next day**, return to the same Metrorail station and tap the card again on a fare vending machine to load the pass.

3. **Tap your card** on a faregate or farebox to use your pass.

→ Loading the pass at a Metrorail station is faster than on a bus and does not risk incurring a negative fare balance.

OPTION 2 Load on Metrobus or DC Circulator

1. Tap your DC One Card on a Metrobus farebox.
2. Wait 3 business days for the pass to become available for loading.



3. **Tap the card** again on any Metrobus farebox to complete loading and to use the pass.

NO PASS, NO FREE RIDE

Until the free pass loads onto your DC One Card, students **MUST** pay regular fare to ride Metrorail, Metrobus or DC Circulator.
